

Hickman Mills C-1 Board of Education and Superintendent Strategic Priorities for 2018-19

- To regain district-wide accreditation by continuing the work underway that has established academic success for all students as the highest priority. This is likely a three (3) to five (5) year goal in light of state protocols and the manner in which calculations are determined.
 - As 2018-19 progresses, report regularly to the board the status of student achievement with an end of year summary depicting overall progress toward the overarching goal. This will include all major academic subjects including math, science.
 - Prepare a report on the district Career and Technical Education programs in terms of student opportunities, community partnerships and successful experiences.
 - Develop strategies and interventions to improve student attendance and report periodically to the board with a recommended plan of action delivered in the Spring of 2019.

- By September 1, develop a board/staff committee system that will begin with Student Learning and Finance.
 - Research and study the formation of committees that are currently being utilized by other districts.
 - Develop board/staff training on committee work (Missouri School Board Assn)

- By September 1, develop a continuous school board development plan
 - The superintendent and board leadership will develop a framework for board attendance at state and national conferences.
 - A retreat (board and staff) will be scheduled by October 1 to continue the work on the development of Operating Principles in critical areas such as communication, decision-making, change, resolving issues that can separate, etc.
 - The board president will ensure that meetings include regular updates on the commitments made at the June retreat and future opportunities for collaborative planning.
